Application Note: Solpadol



Solpadol is a compound analgesic consisting of a combination of phosphate and paracetamol (acetaminophen).

Co-codamol tablets are used for the relief of mild to moderate pain when paracetamol or NSAIDs such as ibuprofen, aspirin or naproxen alone do not sufficiently relieve a patient's symptoms, or where their use is ill-advised.

In 2019, it was the 173rd most commonly prescribed medication in the United States, with more than 3 million prescription
